Environmental Policy Statement

The Company believes that the effective management of environmental issues is essential to the ongoing success of the business. We accept that our activities may impact on the environment and acknowledge our responsibilities in this area. Environmental Management

To ensure the Company's objectives are met, systems will be used to monitor and manage environmental performance in our operations. The key to this will be environmental risk assessments. These will be conducted for all our operations, in compliance with environmental legislation and recognised good practice for our industry sector, and in consultation with our employees and relevant parties who may have a legitimate interest in our activities. Full consultation will take place, where appropriate, with our employees, customers, neighbours and the Environment Agency.

Operating procedures and controls will be developed to reduce any risk to the environment to the "lowest level practicable". Reviews of our environmental performance will be included in regular health and safety inspections and audits.

Energy

Continuous improvement in the efficient use of energy is vital for the continuing prosperity of the company, for reducing global pollution and to conserve energy sources. Focussed objectives will be developed for the management of energy use, and continuous improvement will be encouraged through the use of energy surveys, improved housekeeping, control of processes and the efficient use of resources.

Energy efficiency will be given proper consideration during the purchase and use of our equipment in order that the most energy efficient solution can be adopted whenever financially justifiable.

Waste reduction

All waste represents an inefficient use of resources and energy. We shall aim to reduce the quantity of waste generated by our plant, work equipment, land management and work practices by a continuous programme of waste reduction. These will be regularly reviewed to evaluate routes whereby waste can be eliminated, reduced or recycled.

Training

The Company believes that awareness and knowledge of environmental issues is an important part of the process of effective environmental management. Therefore, it will be an objective to provide suitable information and training to our employees to ensure they are able to make informed decisions and take appropriate decisions in their work activities.
